Hindi Bhasha Pakhwada, a celebration of one of the official languages Hindi, was conducted from 14th September to 30th September with great enthusiasm and fervour at the Regional Institute of English, Chandigarh. Two distinct competitions were organized during this Pakhwada - the Hindi Self-Composed Poetry Writing Competition and the Hindi Paragraph Writing Competition for Group B, C, and D employees. Hindi Self-Composed Poetry Writing Competition was open of both SCERT and RIE. Hindi Paragraph Writing Competition was held for employees of RIE.

1. **Hindi Self-Composed Poetry Writing Competition:** Employees from various departments of SCERT and RIE participated in this event. The participants exhibited their linguistic skills in Hindi and their creative talent by presenting their self-composed Hindi poems.
