#### **About the Institute**

The Regional Institute of English (RIE) was established in 1963 under a scheme of the Government of India to address the educational needs of northern India states i.e. Chandigarh, Jammu & Kashmir, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Punjab and Ladakh. The functioning of the Institute is within the purview of the Chandigarh Administration. The Institute has been working and collaborating with the English and Foreign Languages University (EFL-U), Hyderabad and with state governments in the northern region, CBSE, Panjab University, NCERT, USIEF, British Council and RELO, American Centre, New Delhi in various research projects and teacher training programmes. In 2016, the Institute was accredited by NAAC both for MA English and Teacher Education programmes. Presently the Institute is also covered under RUSA and has conducted many RUSA sponsored courses and workshops.

Since its inception, it has been catering to Educational needs of the region from Primary to Postgraduate level by organizing various need based programmes. It is a pioneer institute in using multimedia for teaching English language. More than 10,000 teachers have benefitted from the various courses in the last ten years. In the past, RIE has conducted courses for International scholars as well, AUSEP being the most recent one. **Afghan University Student Exchange Programme** (AUSEP), a four-week teacher education course in ELT for Afghan undergraduates/graduates was conducted in collaboration with American Centre for four consecutive years i.e. 2011-2014.

RIE is currently running many courses each with a different set of target group i.e. catering to English language needs of people at diverse levels. **Currently** it runs Postgraduate Certificate in the Teaching of English (PGCTE) and Continuous Professional Development course which was initiated in 2016.

#### 1. 117 PGCTE

In Week 1, 'National Education Policy 2020' and its implications for school education were discussed. Special emphasis was given on the topics like interdisciplinary approach, reflective practice teaching, inclusive education, story-telling based pedagogy, assessment for learning, multilingual education, art-integrated learning, critical thinking, supporting students with special needs, social emotional learning and learner autonomy.

The theme of Week 2 was 'Reflective practice teaching/ Action Research' which aims at preparing reflecting practitioners. The different steps of conducting action research were interactively discussed and participants guided to reflect on their classroom problems and carry out a collaborative action research. In each week one session was devoted for reflection and mentoring the action research project.

The focus of Week 3 was on 'Supporting Bilingual/Multilingual learning'. Balancing theoretical input and practical experience, the week discussed different practical strategies of supporting Bilingual/Multilingual learning in the classrooms.

Week 4 was on 'Technology in Education'. In this week the participants were provided hands-on experience in using technological tools for making the teaching-learning more effective.

The theme of Week 5 was 'Understanding Pedagogy: latest trends'. This week aims at preparing the teachers for improving their teaching skills in general and language skills in specific. Different strategies of teaching listening, speaking, reading and writing along with grammar and vocabulary were discussed. In addition, other important topics like pedagogy and inclusive classroom, learner autonomy, gender and experiential learning were discussed.

Week 6 focused on 'Multiple Intelligences and Joyful Learning'. How can we support our students' multiple intelligences and make their learning joyful was the question for the week. Gardner's nine intelligences and their implications for our context were examined. The participants were guided to plan their lessons in order to support multiple intelligences and different learning styles of their students.

Week 7 aimed at preparing teachers for 'Evaluating and Adapting Teaching Materials'. In this week, teachers were guided to examine the appropriateness of the materials they are using, and adapt as per the demand of their context for meeting learning outcomes. They were also made aware of the different factors which were needed to be examined for selecting and adapting print and online materials.

In Week 8, the teachers completed first draft of their 'Reflective Practice Teaching/ Action Research Project' which was started in the second week of the programme.
